- The Board of Directors of the Company at its meeting held on May 25, 2018, had approved the Scheme of Arrangement between the Company, Sun Pharma (Netherlands) B.V. and Sun Pharmaceutical Holdings USA Inc. (both being wholly owned subsidiaries of the Company) which inter-alia, envisages spin-off w.e.f. April 01,2017 of the specified investment undertaking 1 and 2 (as defined in the scheme of Arrangement) of the Company. The scheme shall be effective post receipt of requisite approvals and accordingly, the above results do not reflect the impact, if any, on account of the scheme.
- 4 Effective April 01, 2019, the Company has adopted Ind AS 116 "Leases", applied to all lease contracts existing on April 01, 2019 using the modified retrospective method. Accordingly, the Company has recognised a lease liability measured at the present value of the remaining lease payments, and right-of-use (ROU) asset at an amount equal to lease liability (adjusted for any related prepayments). The impact on the profit and earnings per share for the quarter is not material.

(both being wholly owned subsidiaries of the Company) which inter-alia, envisages spin-off w.e.f. April 01, 2017 of the specified investment undertaking 1 and 2 ( as defined in the scheme of Arrangement ) of the Company. The scheme shall be effective post receipt of requisite approvals and accordingly, the above results do not reflect the impact, if any, on account of the scheme.
- Pursuant to the scheme of arrangement, as approved by the National Company Law Tribunal on October 31, 2018, unbranded generic pharmaceutical undertaking of Sun Pharma Global FZE, a wholly owned subsidiary, has been transferred to the Company w.e.f April 01, 2017. Consequently, effect of the scheme including the tax impact has been given in the financial results in accordance with Ind AS 103 Business Combinations. The results for quarter ended June 30, 2018 have been restated to give effect to the merger.
- Fifective April 01, 2019, the Company has adopted Ind AS 116 "Leases", applied to all lease contracts existing on April 01, 2019 using the modified retrospective method. Accordingly, the Company has recognised a lease liability measured at the present value of the remaining lease payments, and right-of-use (ROU) asset at an amount equal to lease liability (adjusted for any related prepayments). The impact on the profit and earnings per share for the quarter is not material.
- 8 On April 01, 2019, the functional currency of a subsidiary of Taro Pharmaceutical Industries Limited changed from Canadian Dollar to US Dollar. This change in functional currency is applied prospectively with effect from April 01, 2019.
- Pola Pharma Inc. Japan became step down subsidiary of the Company with effect from January 01, 2019. Accordingly, the results for the quarter includes results of Pola Pharma Inc., and hence are not comparable with quarter ended June 30, 2018.
- 10 The Group has only one reportable segment namely 'Pharmaceuticals'.
- 11 The figures for the quarter ended March 31, 2019 represent the derived figures between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year ended March 31, 2019 and the published year-to-date figures up to December 31, 2018, being the date of the end of third quarter of the financial year, which were subjected to a limited review by the statutory auditor of the company.
